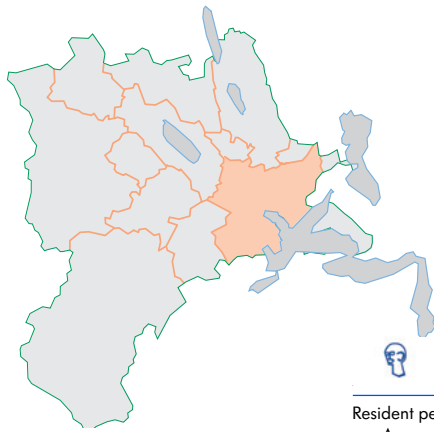

The small dam located in the city of Lucerne regulates the „Reuss“ river

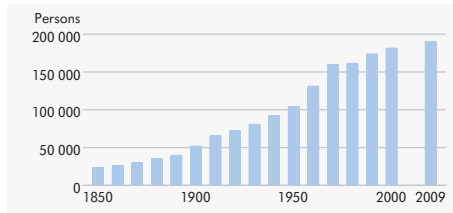
