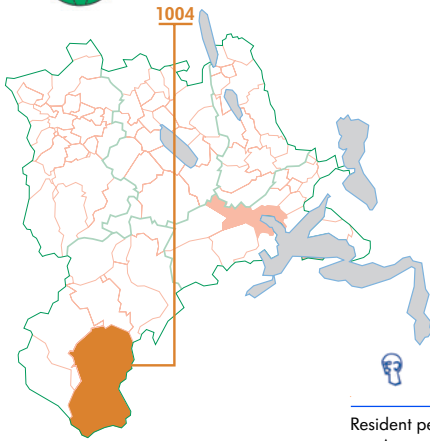




Flühli

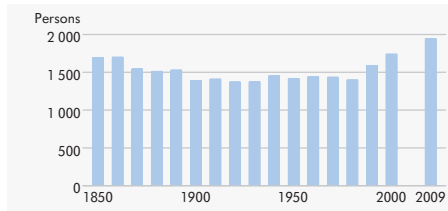
