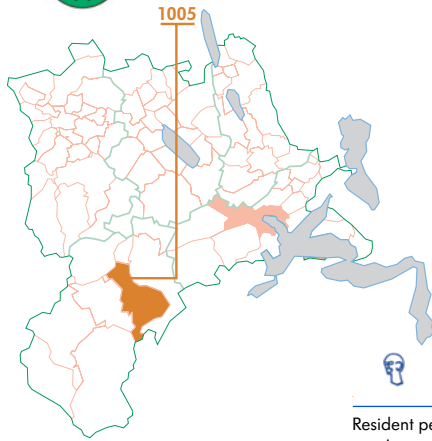




Hasle

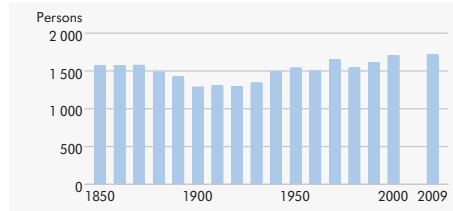
