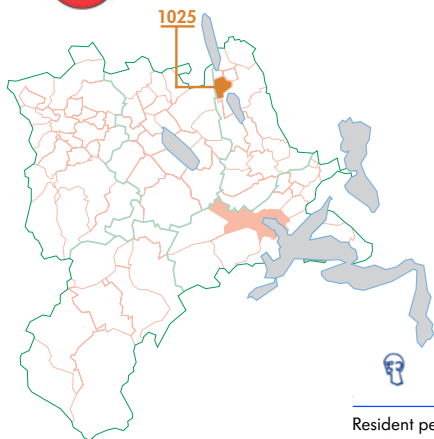




Ermensee

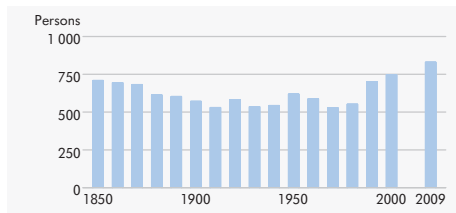
