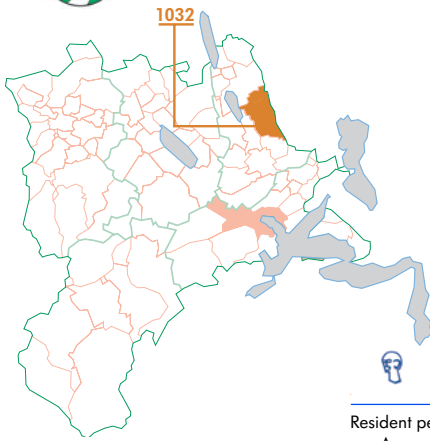




Hohenrain

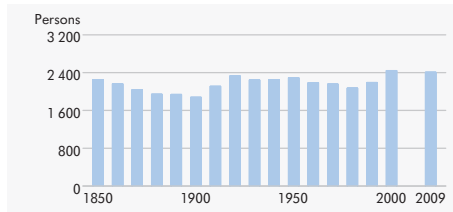
