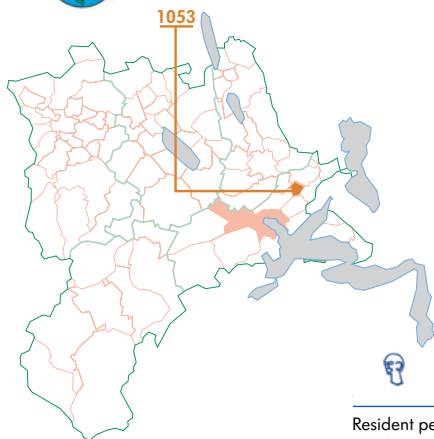




Dierikon

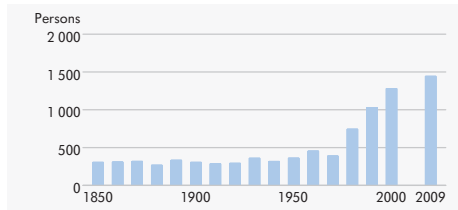
