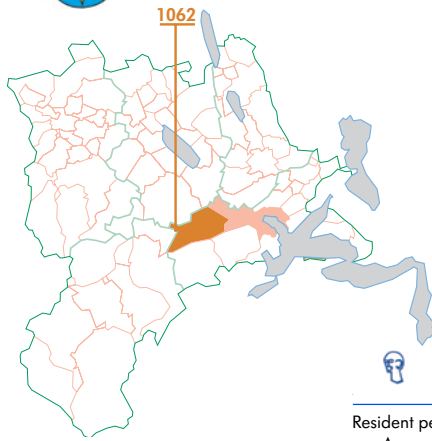




Malters

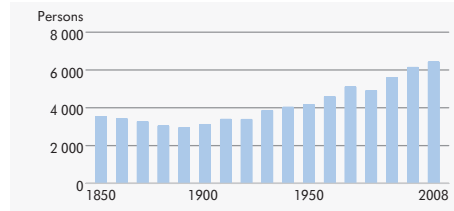
