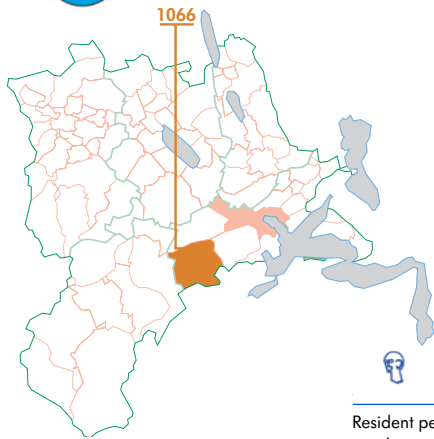




Schwarzenberg

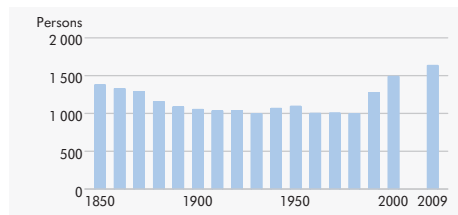
