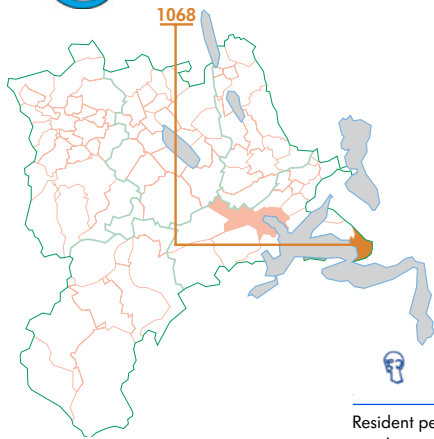




Vitznau

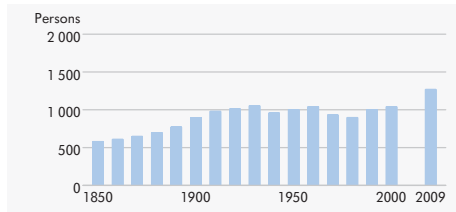
