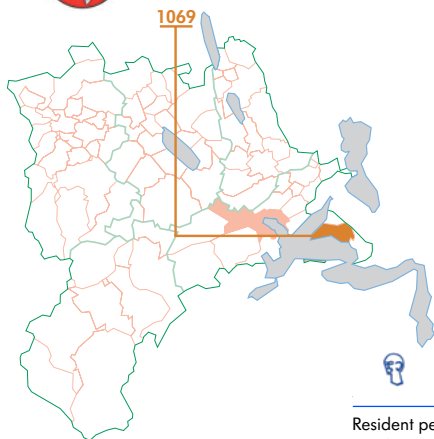




Weggis

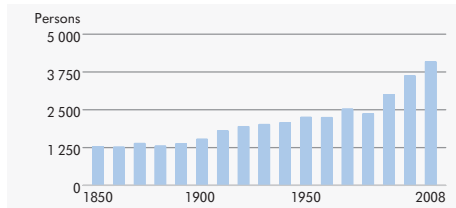
