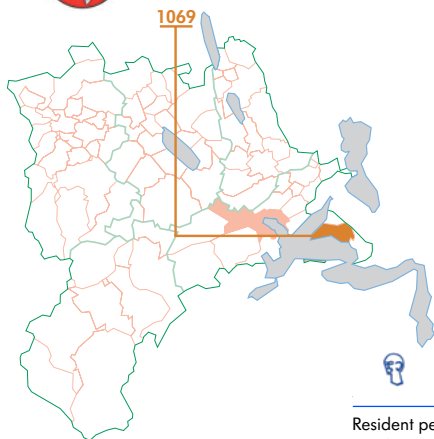




# Weggis

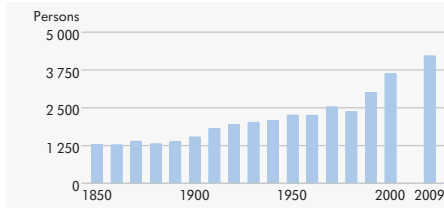
