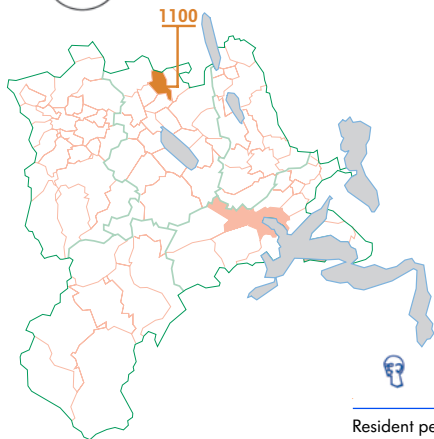




Schlierbach

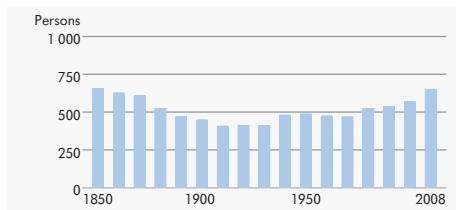
