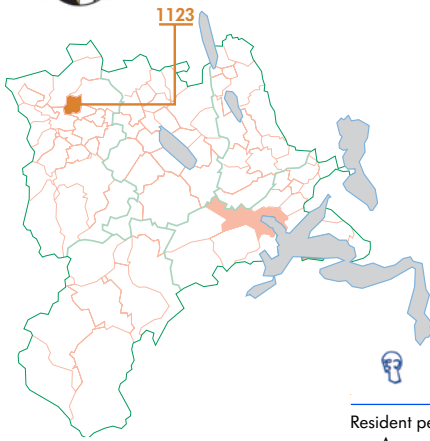




# Altishofen

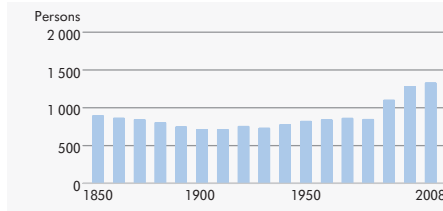
