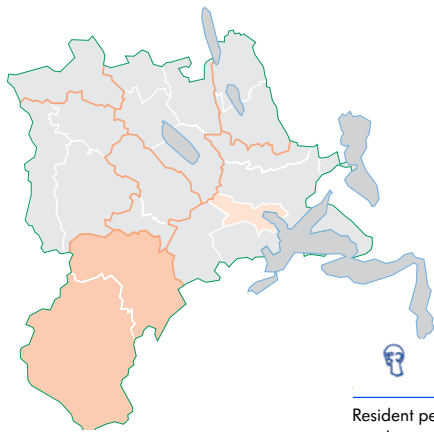


Entlebuch Region

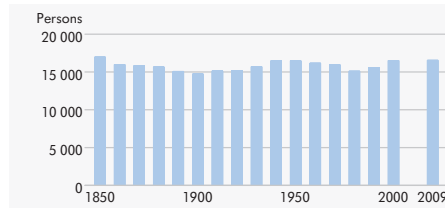
